Homework:

2. Pattern Pumpkins- We have been repeating, and extending patterns in school. Please draw faces on the pumpkins (ex: happy, scary, happy, scary, etc.), color the pumpkins (ex: brown, orange, brown, orange, etc.), OR write letters (ex: A, B, A, B) to make a pumpkin pattern.
