Language Arts



We will continue to:

- Use a variety of methods to represent numbers (tallies, the numeral, pictures, etc.)
- Compare sets that are equal and unequal using the correct vocabulary (more, less, equal)
- Begin identifying sets as being odd or even.

Science/Social Studies



We will:

- Identify the signs of fall by using our five senses.
- Identify different types of weather, the seasons, the water cycle, and how weather affects the way we dress, things we do, and places we go.
- Compare and contrast traditions of families living today and in the past.
